for any seven musicians

Each musician selects a soft, simple sound of any duration.

Each musician is allocated a number from 1 to 7.

The musicians go through the series of boxes, in the given order (in rows), but may start and stop at any point.

If a musician's number is in the box, they must play their sound.

If the numbers are in a vertical line, the sounds should be played simultaneously. If they are horizontal, then there should be a short pause between the start of each sound – the sounds may overlap.

There should be a long pause between boxes.
